Another Abolition Outrage.

THEY TRY TO RUN OFF FORTY SLAVES ONE OF THE JAYHAWKERS SHOT

INDEPENDENCE, Dec. 11.—During last night a party of Abolitionists went to the residence of Morgan Walker, living ten miles southeast of this city—the owner of about forty negroes—and demanded them, saying that he, their proprietor, should not be hurt. Walker told them to take the negroes, and commenced shooting. One of the gang fell dead on the steps ; one was taken prisoner, and the messenger thought two others were killed. Walker had been apprised beforehand of their approach, and was prepared. Montgomery once lived in neighborhood for a short time.
